<u>Approval of Inter-local Agreement with the City of San Angelo for the New Freedom Pedestrian</u> <u>Improvement Project Resolution 121014A</u>

John Austin Stokes, CVTD Executive Director, noted the key issues of this Inter-local which are:

- CVTD will grant contractual authority to the City of San Angelo
- City of San Angelo is obligated to come up with all of the matching funds
- City of San Angelo will submit billing to TxDOT, but on the Phase III Funds will let CVTD review them
 prior to submitting
- CVTD will be responsible for compliance on the Phase III Funds and CVTD will receive credit for ensuring compliance

Upon a motion by Judge Floyd, seconded by Mayor Morrison, approval of Inter-local Agreement with the City of San Angelo for the New Freedom Pedestrian Improvement Project **Resolution 121014A** was unanimously approved.
