Update on the CVTD FY 2014 FTA Triennial Review

John Austin Stokes, CVTD Executive Director, reported that the FTA has not yet completed their review of CVTD's ADA Corrective Action. All other findings have been closed. Once this Corrective Action is closed the final report will be brought before the board for approval.

Reports and Information Items

- John Austin Stokes informed the board that we are looking forward to staff from McDonald Transit to begin on site visits in late August. McDonald Transit support staff will be coming in to assess the current status of CVTD's overall operations and management systems.
- With funds provided by TXDOT CVTD placed an order against the Texas Comptroller Smart Buy contract for two low floor buses, four Ford Transit XL two wheel chair position vans, one F150 regular cab P/U and one F150 crew cab P/U. With remaining FTA funds from the urban bus purchase CVTD placed an order against a Smart Buy contract for one Ford Transit XL two wheel chair position van and one Ford Focus Sedan.

Public Comment

Mr. Jim Ryan wanted to comment on Route 2 and some issues that he has getting to the bus stop. Staff informed Mr. Ryan that CVTD plans on evaluating the routes sometime in mid-October to come up with recommendations for changes and then present those for public comment in the latter half of October.
