MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN CONCHO VALLEY TRANSIT DISTRICT (CVTD) & SAN ANGELO METROPOLITAN ORGANIZATION (SA-MPO)

WHEREAS, the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) promulgated regulations 23 CFR 450.314; and

WHEREAS, the San Angelo Metropolitan Planning Organization (SA-MPO) which is the designated MPO for San Angelo and Tom Green County along with the Public Transportation Operator(s) shall cooperatively determine their mutual responsibilities in carrying out the metropolitan transportation planning process; and

WHEREAS, these responsibilities shall be clearly identified in written agreements among the MPO and the Public Transportation Operator(s), namely Concho Valley Transit District, serving the Metropolitan Planning Area, and

WHEREAS, to the extent possible, a single agreement between all responsible parties should be developed; and

WHEREAS, all interested agencies, organizations, and person have been given opportunity to be heard with respect to any matters relating to the proposed Public Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Public Participation Plan meets or exceeds the requirements of federal and state regulations:

WHEREAS, the federal regulations require the written agreement to include specific provisions for cooperatively developing and sharing information related to the development of financial plans that support the metropolitan transportation plan, the metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program ("TIP"), and development of the annual listing of obligated projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Purpose: To provide a single agreement between the San Angelo MPO and Concho Valley Transit District in accordance with current Federal Legislation and to make provision for cooperative mutual responsibilities in carrying out the Metropolitan Planning Process in the San Angelo Metropolitan Planning Area. CVTD vows to adopt and utilize the approved SAMPO Public Participation Plan as their own, and will follow the same processes and procedures in informing and involving the public in major transportation service changes; the Public Participation Plan contains guidelines for applicable public transportation providers operating within the MPO boundary.

2. Responsibilities of both parties

All parties will:

- a. Cooperatively determine their mutual responsibilities in carrying out the public participation process.
- b. Make provisions for cooperatively developing and sharing information related to the development of financial plans that support the Metropolitan Transportation Plan ("MTP") and TIP as it pertains to any public participation processes or procedures.
- c. Ensure that CVTD and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects that comprehensively address the transportation system within the MPO boundaries. Identified projects shall include both roadway and transit initiatives, including but not limited to investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities for which federal funds were obligated in preceding program years.

3. Responsibilities of the MPO

The MPO will:

- a. Work in consultation with CVTD in developing the program of projects and financial plan for the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
- b. Work in consultation with CVTD in developing the program of projects and financial plan for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).
- c. Conduct Technical Committee and Policy Board meetings as required and necessary.
- d. In consultation with CVTD, update the MTP and TIP in accordance with State and Federal laws.
- e. Invite CVTD to participate in all public participation processes.
- f. Produce an advertisement in the urbanized area official organ that includes CVTD's latest program of projects and financial information in accordance with current Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Legislation.
- g. Conduct comprehensive, cooperative and continuous transportation planning for the San Angelo Metropolitan Planning Area, including updating the Public Participation Plan in accordance with FTA timelines.

4. Responsibilities of the Concho Valley Transit District

Concho Valley Transit District will:

- a. Assist in validation of data used as input into the transportation plan and program of projects.
- b. Work in consultation with the MPO in developing the program of projects and financial plan for the MTP.
- c. Work in consultation with the MPO in developing the program of projects financial plan for the TIP.
- d. Provide the MPO with the annual list of transit obligated projects.
- e. Notify the MPO of changes to projects that would affect the MTP or TIP.
- f. Invite the MPO to participate in all public participation processes.
- 5. <u>Term</u>. This Memorandum shall become effective as to each Party when approved and executed by that Party. It shall remain in full force and effect until such time it is terminated in writing by one or all of the parties.
- **6.** Validity and Enforceability. If any current or future legal limitations affect the validity or enforceability of a provision of this Agreement, then the legal limitations are made a part of this memorandum and shall operate to amend this memorandum to the minimum extent necessary to bring this memorandum into conformity with the requirements of the limitations, and so modified, this memorandum shall continue in full force and effect.

EXECUTED by the parties hereto, each respective entity acting by and through its duly authorized official as required by law.
